Solemn opening ceremony of the academic year 2021-2022

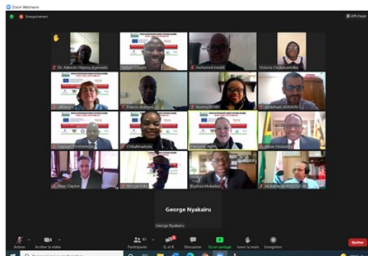
